To whom it may concern

As President of the Grande Cache Historical Society, I am very supportive of the Grande Cache Heritage Rendezvous Festival and their plan to celebrate our history. The Grande Cache region has a long and storied past going back to the dinosaurs, through the indigenous migrations and the fur trade.

The fur trade has special importance to the region as our town was actually named for a winter fur eache built by Ignace Giasson of the Hudson's Bay Company in 1819 after a trading trip over the mountains to the west. Apparently, on his return, his expedition hit heavy, deep snow and Giasson decided to build a large (grande) fur eache to store his furs which he would retrieve in the spring. In addition, Pierre Grey ran a trading post at the lakes named in his honour in the late 1800's. There was a short-lived trading post at the Beans Creek near Susa Creek run by the Woodley brothers from 1916 to 1925, a trading post at Victor Lake run by Ewan Moberty in the early 190°s and trading posts as Sheep Creek and Victor Lake run by the Unruhs from 1934 to 1941. In the years when there was no trading post in the local area, the indigenous people and other trappers would make their way to the Woodley Brothers store in Entrance to trade their catches.

I believe that this festival will be very beneficial for Grande Cache as it will increase awareness of our history, provide educational opportunities for all, and provide an opportunity for cur local indigenous people to showcase an important part of their culture and traditions.
